

Barbara Buckley, A Short Biography



Barbara Buckley serves as the Speaker of the Nevada Assembly, the first woman in our state's history to hold this position. During her tenure, she has sponsored legislation enacting a patient's bill of rights, child welfare, and consumer protection.

She also serves as the Executive Director of Clark County Legal Services, Inc., a nonprofit public interest law firm providing legal advice, representation and advocacy for individuals who cannot afford a lawyer. In that capacity, she has designed new programs to help provide legal assistance to the disadvantaged, including a program to provide attorneys for abused and neglected children.

Barbara graduated summa cum laude from the University of Arizona Law School and received her Bachelor of Arts degree from UNLV. Barbara is married and has two sons.
